The online learning programme will include the following:

1. Live Zoom classes following the time table issued on EduPage starting from **17th August 2020**, where teachers will deliver instruction, teach new content, and support their students via zoom video platform.
2. The timetable outlines the days and timings that your child is to attend the zoom classes. Please strictly follow the days & timings outlined in your child's class time table.
3. Please download Zoom 5.0 on your desktop/laptop or mobile device if you haven't done so already.
4. It is preferred that students join Zoom classes via laptop or desktop computer , however we are mindful of the fact that some families are sharing devices, in which case, if no other option is available, then students may join by tablet/mobile device.
5. Google classroom and EduPage will be used to post assignments and relevant resources for students to work online.

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STUDENT GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE LEARNING

Zoom Meeting Guidelines for students

- Be on time for your meeting, log in a few minutes ahead of time to avoid panic.
- Check your device, make sure it's charged overnight and that it is working properly.
- Test the headsets, camera and microphones before the meeting to ensure everything is working smoothly.
- Turn off other devices and put your phone on silent during the meeting.
- Bring your resource pack and required materials to the session such as textbooks, copies, stationery to avoid any unnecessary delay during the session.
- Students must login to Zoom with their full name as their display name and video on.
- The display name and video will be used by the teachers to identify the student to admit him/her in the class.
- Keep the zoom link and password handy (provided by the teacher) before joining each session.
- If multiple people in the house are using Zoom, keep yourselves away in separate rooms with doors closed as wireless interference will affect the quality of the call.
- Mute your mic (lower-left corner of your screen) as soon as you sign on and whenever you are not speaking.
- Keep your notebook in front of you and take notes during the meeting for completing action items after the online session.

The use of online tools to engage our students in a virtual learning environment is a new experience for many of our educators and learners at ISK. The success of our online learning endeavour is a partnership and is dependent on careful planning by our faculty, appropriate student motivation and engagement, and strong parent support. While some things may work, others may pose challenges, kindly bear with us while we try to figure out what works best for our students.
